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Everyone loves cookies! In this activity, your child can practice reading or spelling by "baking" cookies. Customize this activity by using the words your child is currently learning.


Instructions

Print pages 3 and 4 of this activity (double-sided). Cut out the "cookie dough" cards.

For reading practice: On the cookie dough side of the cards, write in the words that your child is learning to read. Place the cards in a pile with the words facing up. Have your child bake the cookies by choosing a card and reading the word aloud. If he reads the word correctly, he can turn the card over to reveal a freshly baked cookie.

For spelling practice: Dictate spelling words for your child to write on each cookie dough card. If he spells the word correctly, he can turn the card over to reveal a freshly baked cookie.


Continue playing until all the cookies have been baked.
















